Dear OHM folks,

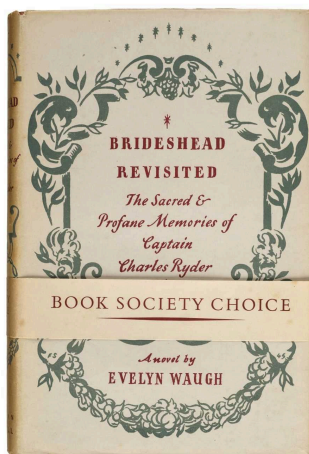

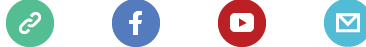
