

To submit feedback to the Article II Study Commission, follow this <u>link</u>. Any UU may submit feedback. "Each suggestion or idea should describe specific language changes to the proposal, explain the reason, and be limited to a single section of Article II. Individuals may submit multiple suggestions and ideas."

The timeframe to submit feedback is April 1 - 30. After April 15, "all qualifying suggestions" (whatever that means) will be posted publicly at <u>discuss.uua.org</u>. We suggest you bookmark this webpage. You do not need a login profile to submit feedback, but a login profile is needed to participate in future discussions. All are encouraged to get a discuss.uua.org profile. Go to discuss.uua.org and select the Sign Up button at the top of the screen.
